Description:

The Certificate II in Dance is a vocational program delivered to secondary students (VDSS) that can be commenced in Year 10 or 11 and completed over 1 to 3 years (if completing Certificate III in Dance).

Certificate II develops foundational technical dance skills, creativity, and confidence for students interested in the live performance industry. Students explore a range of dance styles while developing fitness, teamwork, and performance skills in a supportive studio environment.

You will learn things like:

- Basic dance techniques across a range of styles, including Jazz, Contemporary, Ballet, Lyrical, tap, Street, and Cultural
- Performance skills for stage and screen
- Safe dance practices and injury prevention
- Stage presence, confidence, and teamwork
- Understanding the live performance industry
- Preparing for auditions and performance
