Certificate III in Dance develops advanced technical dance skills, creativity and performance ability for students pursuing further study or careers in the performance arts. Students refine technique, choreography and stage performance while working collaboratively in a professional studio environment.

Students enrolling in Certificate III in Dance must have successfully completed Year 1 – Certificate II in Dance in the previous year. Units will be delivered and assessed in a sequence planned by the trainer.

- Advanced dance techniques
- Develop performance skills for live and recorded contexts
- Apply safe dance practices in rehearsals and performances
- Work collaboratively in creative teams
- Demonstrate stage presence and audience engagement

Course Length:

- The courses are typically delivered over 12 to 2 years as part of the VET delivered in schools (VDSS) program.
- Scored Assessment: To be eligible for a study score, students must successfully achieve all Units of competence designated as the Units 3 & 4 sequence and a solo performance examination in the end-of-year examination period. Year three is predominantly a practical year and has no examination, but can contribute to a study score as a 5th or 6th subject increment or can be completed unscored.
